Please go over these rules with your child

In order to maintain an excellent relationship with Branksome Hall, our host March break private school and to achieve the best possible classes, for everyone, it is necessary for our parents and students to follow these rules and policies.

1. **Please ensure your child has a USB stick to bring to class.** For safety sake, your son or daughter should bring home a back up of their game code, on their USB stick after each day.
2. Due to the logistics of a March break camp, there are no make up classes for the one week March camp.
3. **Please try hard to be on time. (This really makes the classes better for all the students)**
4. Please note that we are unable to properly supervise students who are not in a class. Therefore we ask parents & guardians to drop off and pick up their children as close to designated start/finish times as possible.
5. Parents can quietly sit in on the classes for observation purposes but parents must remain in the computer lab area and can not wander around the school.
6. Parents cannot interfere with the teaching if they choose to observe the class. Only students are allowed to use the school computers; parents are not allowed to use the computers.
7. Computers are for appropriate student class work only. Access to the Internet is strictly monitored. RP4K reserves the right to restrict or limit students use of the internet during class.
8. No consumption of food or drinks is allowed near the Branksome computers or other Branksome electronic equipment.
9. Our students (& parents) must be on their best behavior all the time, however should a child create unnecessary disruptions during a class, we will call home to notify the parent or guardian. If after the one phone call, the child's behavior is not improved, RP4K reserves the right to expel the student with no refund. No foul language, bullying of other students or abuse of Branksome computers will be tolerated.
10. **Refund Policy:**
 - a. To cancel a March break course, parents must notify our head office by calling 416-469-9676 or emailing rp4kelliott@gmail.com with significant advance notice prior to the March break camp
 - b. **Deposits are non-refundable** after Feb 1st , 2010
 - c. **Balances are non-refundable** after Feb 22nd , 2010
 - d. **Our high quality guarantee:** If after ATTENDING the first 2 days of a March break camp, then as long as you withdraw your child before the 3rd day, you can receive a 100% refund, with penalty waived and no loss of deposit.

Fee Payment and scheduling your child's March break camp:

- All March break camps take place at Branksome Hall School, between March 15-19th (2010), Monday to Friday, 9 am -12 pm, 1 pm-4 pm or all day.
- RP4K will be running 3 labs of a max of 4 students per lab for the March 15-19th break. This strictly limits our enrollment to 24 students. Therefore March break camps are sold on a First Come First Serve basis and are held by deposit only. **Please call and register early to ensure your child's participation in RP4K's March break camp.**

- All discounts are applied to the total but should be deducted from the final payment

Discounts:

- **15% Trail Blazer Discount** for full payment of the March break camp received prior to December 24th - 2009.
 - Since we let demand dictate what courses we offer over the March break “trail blazers” also get the advantage of influencing our March break course offering.
- **10% Early Bird Discount** for full payment of the March break camp received prior to January 18th - 2010
- **5% Veteran Student Discount:** A “Veteran” Student is defined as an RP4K student who has taken at least two different RP4K courses.
- **Group Discounts:** Applies to two or more students signing up together spearheaded by one guardian who single handedly schedules the 2,3 or 4 member group. All students must be in the same class.
 - Group of 2: 5% Discount for each of 2 Students
 - Group of 3: 7.5% Discount for each of 3 Students
 - Group of 4: 10% Discount for each of 4 Students
- **Family Discounts:** 5% Discount for each family member signed up.
- **Only one percentage discount can apply:** The preceding percentage discounts can not be combined. You can only receive one of the preceding discounts. RP4K customers receive the best discount that applies.
- **Referral Discount: RP4K appreciates referrals.** If you are a first time RP4K customer that was referred by an existing RP4K customer you will receive a \$50 credit towards your first RP4K course. In addition the referring family also receives a \$50 credit on their next RP4K course. This discount can be combined with one of the preceding percentage discounts.

- Alice (Magic show), Beginner Visual Basic (Frogger) and Beginner+ (Pacman) are each half day camps (either 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM or 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM)
- The Early start programming course uses a Programming Language called “Alice”, which was developed by Carnegie Mellon University. This course has been researched and developed by Scott King B.Math (Honours) B.Ed. and is aimed at 8 to 9 year olds with strong logic skills but weaker computer & typing skills. Scott King will also be teaching the ALICE (Magic show) course. Alice can be freely distributed to our students just like Visual Basic, Java and C#.
- Developing Visual Basic (Donkey Kong), Developing+ Visual Basic (Mario), Intermediate Java (Retro Asteroids) and Intermediate+ C# (Shooter) are each full day camps. (9:00 AM to 4:00 PM with a 1 hour lunch break from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM)
